Dear Concerned Community Members:

This is an update of the progress to investigate and resolve the odour issue. We have made several modifications so that we can start to pinpoint or rule out potential sources of the odour. They are as follows:

- We have shutdown our water-cooling tower until May 13th, 2010. Mill water is pumped to this tower to recover the heat and reuse the water in the mill. Because this tower is located outside of the two main buildings, the air movement around this tower could mobilize any odours that may exist in this water and potentially disperse the odours outside of the building. The cost of this trial bypass of the cooling tower is that we are introducing more fresh water into our process to make up for the lack of this water.
- Our Algas water system has also been shut down. This system allowed us to reuse our process water. Without it operational, we will also need to introduce more fresh water into our process to meet our water needs. We will have this system down until May 13th, 2010 as well.
- Tomorrow (Apr. 28th, 2010), we will be vacuuming out the solids of the sand-settling tank at the end of our effluent treatment process. We suspect this tank as a potential source of odour, so we will clean it out.

We appreciate notification if you smell the same odour that we are trying to eliminate. Your help and understanding is very much appreciated throughout this period of identifying the root cause of the odour. There are other actions that we are working on that will take some time to implement. As progress develops, I will provide an update.
